Navigate to the English, Spanish or ASL version of the training. Make sure you are logged in and your profile is complete first!

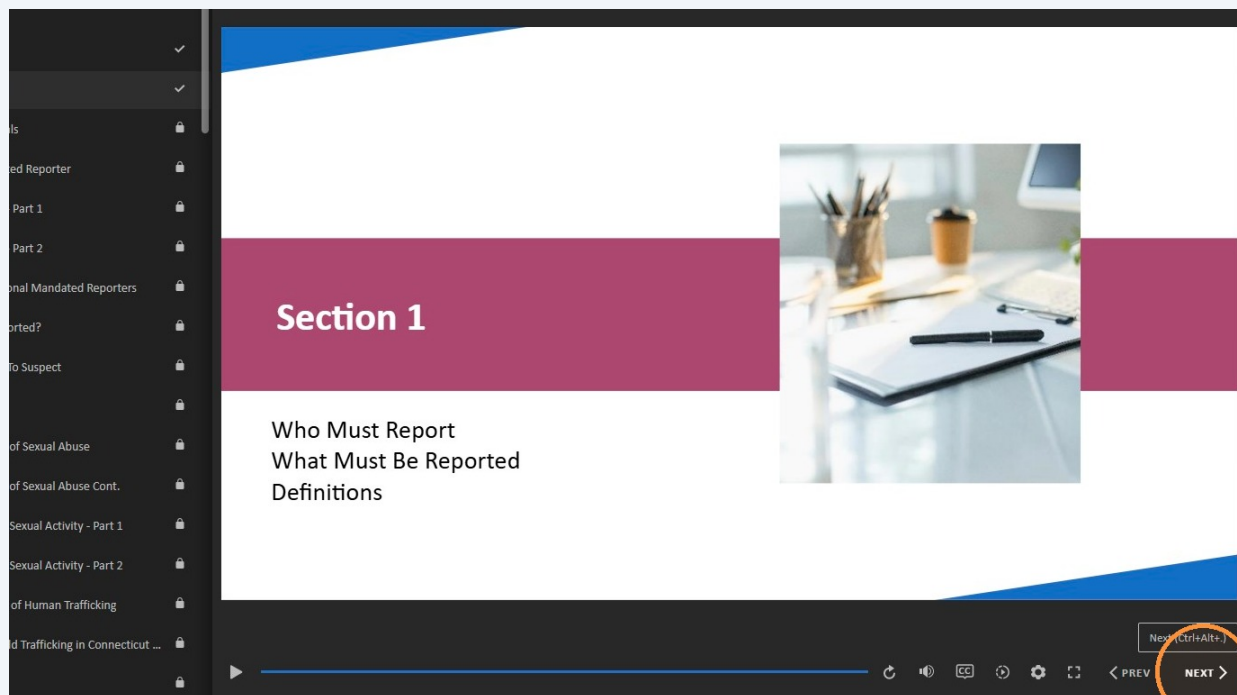

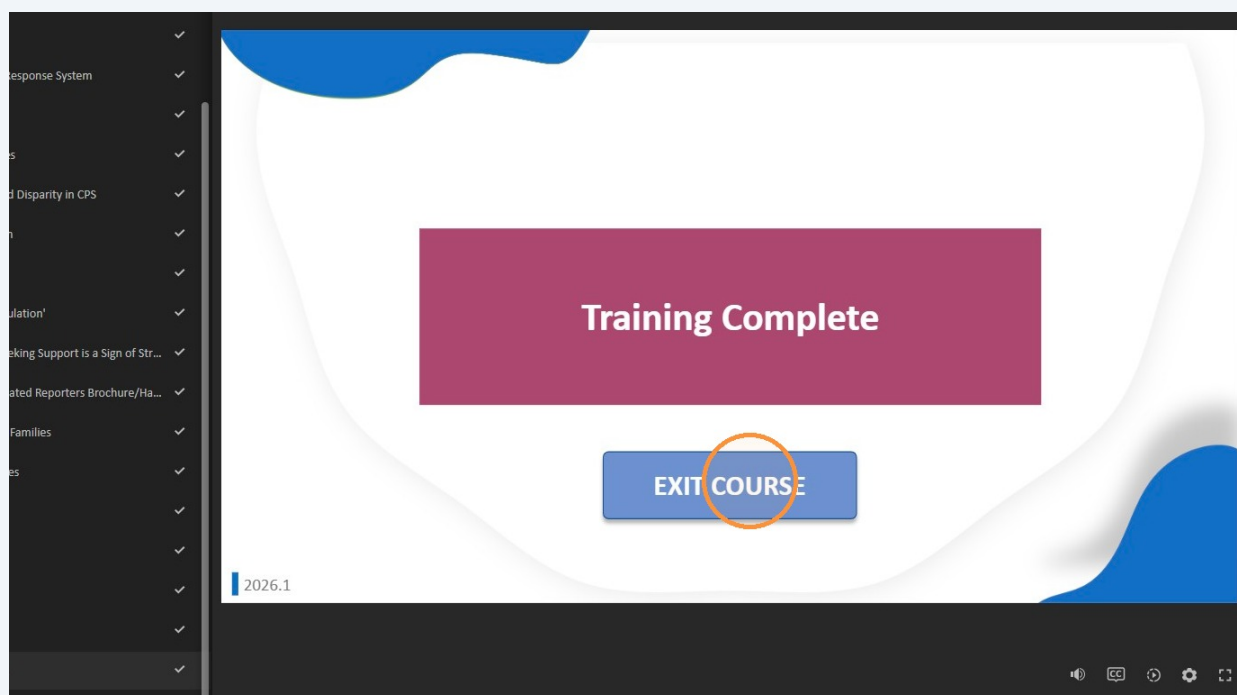

You can pause the narration, use subtitles, or speed up/slow down the narration by using the buttons at the bottom of the screen.

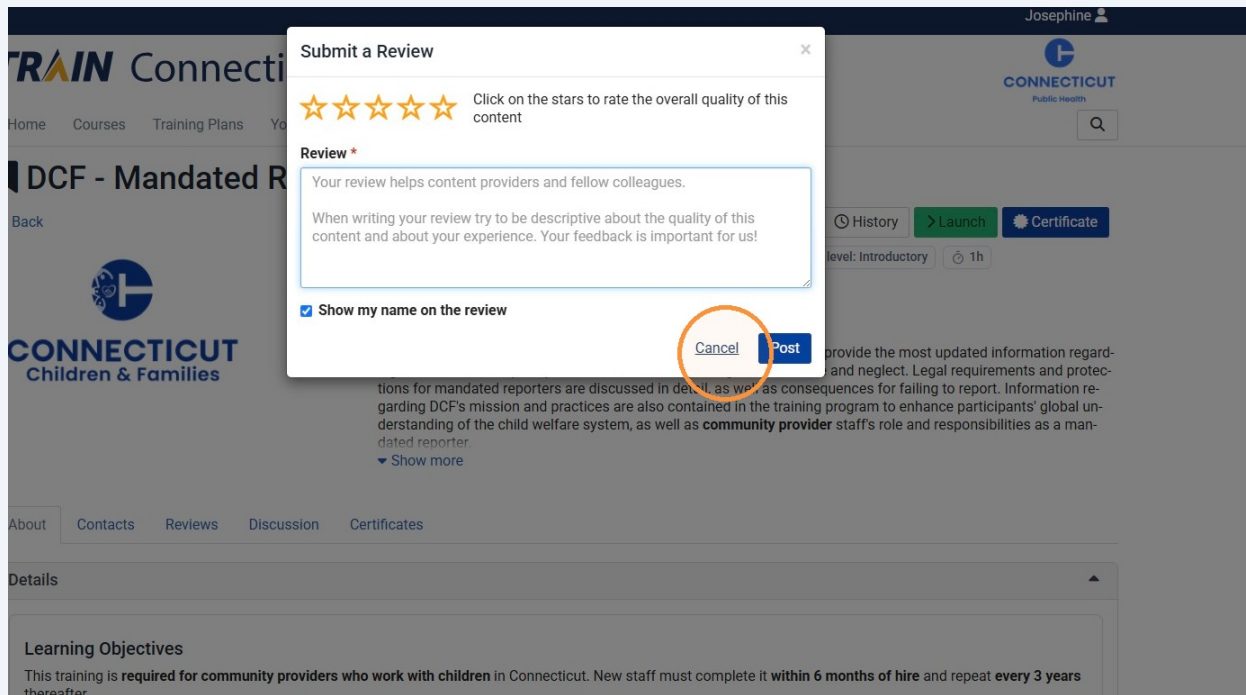


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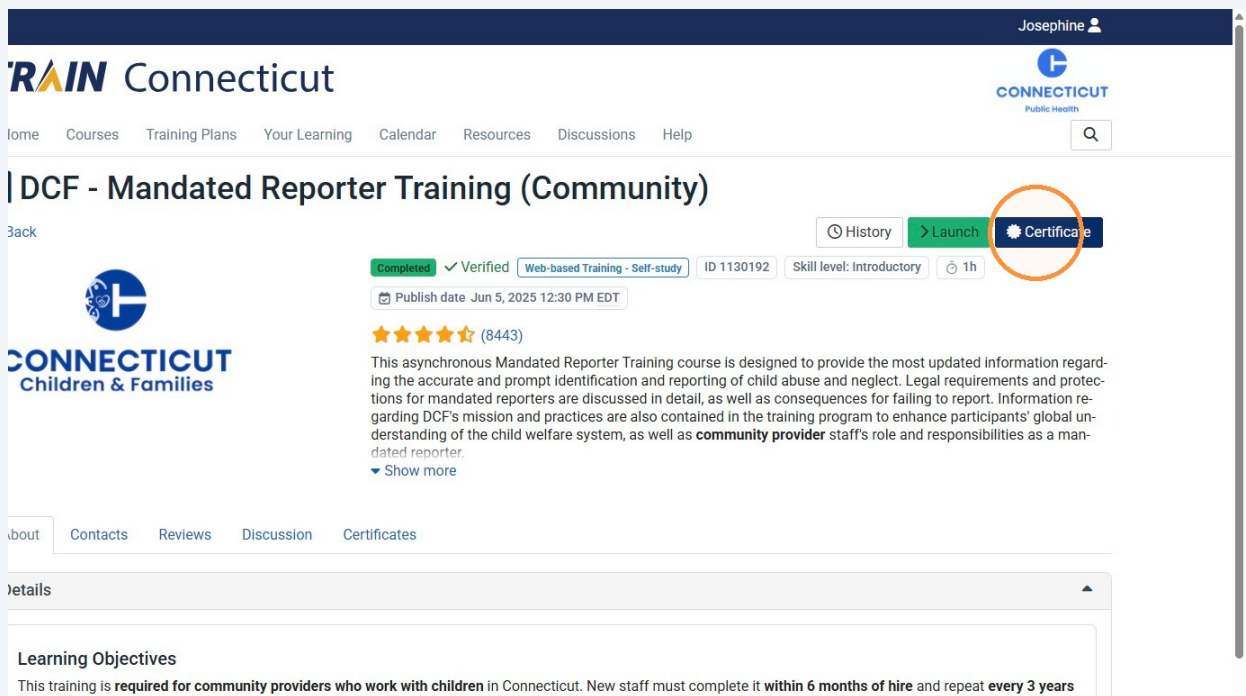
When you have completed all of the training click the Exit Course button.



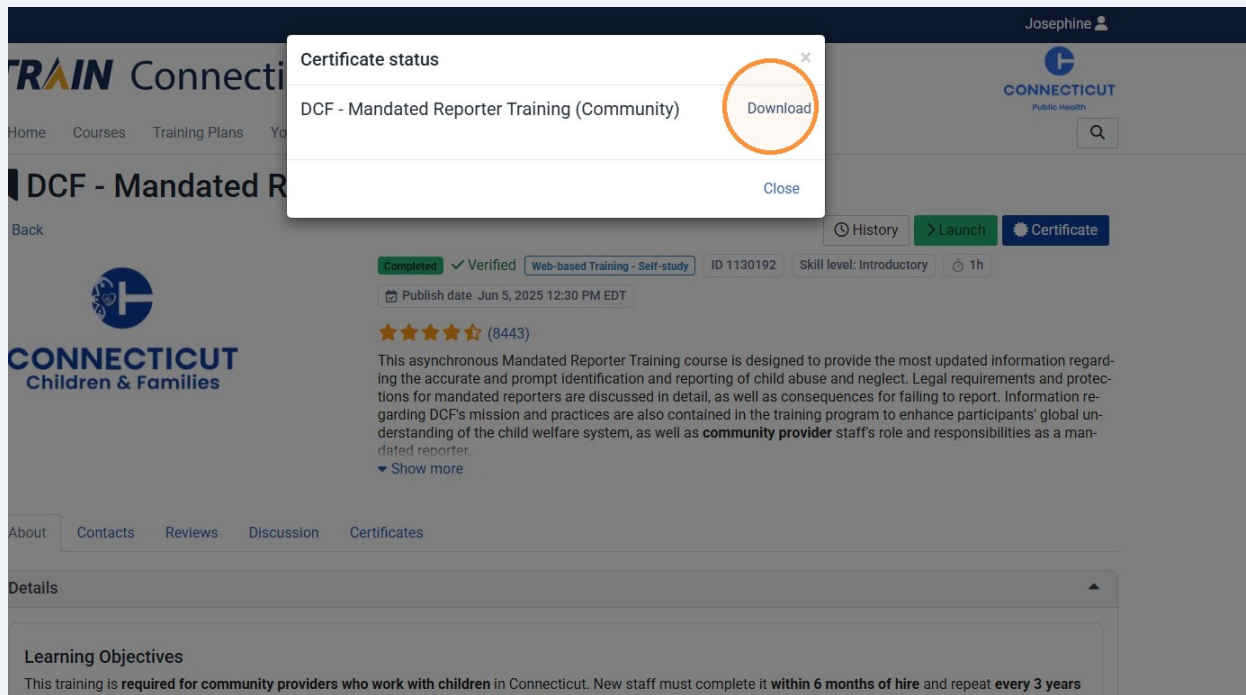
